AMERICA'S WAR ON LOVE AND HUMANITY - AN OPEN LETTER

Why America is trying to destroy the marriage of a peaceful, loving couple. NB. This will possibly lead to a very expensive lawsuit on the grounds of discrimination, physical abuse, denial of human rights, illegal deportation, etc.

I returned from America on 30th December after being held in custody at a detention centre for illegal immigrants for nearly three months. How I came to be involved in this predicament is not entirely my fault. It all began because America decided, at a mere whim, that it would use it's might to crush the hopes and dreams of a loving couple. The reason for my recent incarceration was due to my desperate attempt to regain my personal possessions and to go and see my wife. This was my only 'crime'.

My nightmare actually began on 30th January, 2008, and I shall write in greater depth about my experiences further into this letter. But for now, I ask you to understand that I have seen the worst of a 'Satanic' American regime hell-bent on inflicting suffering upon it's victims.

At this point I would interject and add that my own (UK) government has remained intransigent and refuses to uphold the human rights of it's own citizens when travelling to America. It is not just me that has suffered at the hands of evil American immigration officials, I have learned of others who have also fallen foul of these monsters. What does our government do to protect or represent us in America? The answer is nothing.

The UK is just as guilty as America by condoning the mistreatment of UK travellers to America by virtue of doing nothing to protect them. Gordon Brown, our Prime Minister, and his miserable band of cohorts are tainted by their mealy-mouthed words and feeble subjugation to the will of the 'Great Satan' of American - the Republican administration.

The outgoing Republican administration is alleged to have been influenced by extreme right-wing Christian influences. What follows is an argument supporting this opinion.

Right-wing 'Christian' America

I have seen how America has waged illegal and unjustified wars against those it deems too weak to defend themselves. America's current crusade appears to be against Islamic elements it considers uncivilised and hostile to peace and democracy. But does America's war against it's enemies really just involve such elements? Or does America's war go much further - is it, in fact, a war against love and humanity itself?

I would argue that it is such a war. America does not like to be challenged, let alone attacked. And when it does respond, it does so with such force that it exceeds what would normally be considered rational or proportional.

This is because America is the 'playground bully' of the modern world. Unwilling to show any weakness, any challenge to its brutal position of power has to be met with a show of extreme force.

America pretends to be a Christian state. But what exactly does Christianity mean to Americans? As a (previously) regular visitor to this country, I have seen American Christians and observed their mentality, tried to de-construct their perceptions and to analyse their understanding of their self-professed faith.

Essentially, American Christians have a very high opinion of themselves. For all intense purposes they can be kind, considerate and understanding. But because of their strong devotion to their faith, they refuse to accept realities about their country when it challenges their sanitised view of their faith.

Some of these Christians (which I would loosely term as 'Palinites') are so convinced that 'God' (whose God?) justifies their right to make war that they are beyond any reason. Then there are the Christians who say that to go to war is wrong, but refuse to accept that their country can do any wrong when going to war.

These are the Christians who will say that their country should not have waged war on countries such as Iraq and Afghanistan, but support America's troops without question - regardless of the fact that to be any part of such hostility is strictly forbidden by their religion.

Essentially, American Christians can do no wrong. And so obsessed are they with their faith, they refuse to accept that salvation can be achieved other than by accepting Jesus Christ. And it is ONLY by accepting the Christian faith can one be saved. Other religions are doomed to some other fate. How they be perceived to be anything else than self-righteous and arrogant? Let's not forget they are American Christians - they are above all others by their own definition.

This means trouble for the rest of the planet. When a race are so wrapped-up in, so involved in, so deeply convicted to such a blinding faith, then any power they achieve can be wielded without recrimination. Their 'God' sanctifies their every action and puts them beyond responsibility.

My own feelings for America are mixed. I made numerous friends of varying spiritual practices. I even made friends with some of these Christians who feel their own government and country is beyond reproach. And even when they accepted their government had done wrong, they could not feel any incrimination. This is likely due to the fact that they felt their President was infallible or simply (at worst) mistaken in his judgement. You only have to proclaim to be a Christian in America and you become fireproof. This is a good insurance policy for those misguided enough to think they can escape the flames of Hell just by saying they are Christians.

Perhaps this is why some of my so-called Christian friends are reluctant to help me with my current predicament (I shall discuss this shortly). I refuse to accept Jesus Christ as an exclusive saviour. It's not enough I accept him as a possible saviour. Membership of the American Christian Society demands exclusivity. Ergo, I am not considered worthy of any physical effort to resolve my problems with those American authorities I've accused of corruption.

This brings me to the issue of my travels to America since November, 2004. The reader will see, and hopefully understand, that all I have ever tried to do, is the 'right thing'.

My Story ...

After chatting to a few American ladies on internet dating sites prior to this time, I met one lady whom I thought worthy of a transatlantic adventure. In November, 2004, I flew to Canada to meet her in Vancouver, British Columbia ("BC"). I would have flown directly to America, but being unsure of the hysterical immigration regulations that currently existed in America, I thought that at least we would get to meet in a much more welcoming country. Not that immigration control at Vancouver airport are that 'friendly'. Nevertheless, we met and spent a few days in the city.

We then journeyed South and crossed the border at the Pacific Highway crossing. A friendly and very reasonable Hawaiian immigration officer allowed me to enter America and spend the rest of my short (one month) vacation there with my new-found love.

This relationship did not work out. But having spent some time in this lady's part of the world, I felt that I would like to return some day. By November, 2006, and after two wretched years in the UK, I eventually got to realise my dream.

The original plan was to meet a lady from Bend, Oregon. But she became seriously ill and called off our internet-based friendship-cum-relationship. But having already bought my plane tickets, and being so depressed at life in the UK, I decided to go ahead and visit other female friends I met on the internet over the previous 12 months.

My story of this trip, and all my following trips to America, are described in the attached immigration court statement I made in November, 2008. Please now refer to this document, and then return to this letter.

My life has been wrecked by corruption in the American immigration system. Having been such a peaceful, respectful and worthwhile visitor to America for such a long time, I have now seen my life slowly disintegrate as I try to get justice, regain my possessions, and to see my wife.

America has shown me, without any doubt at all, that it is against true justice, it is against love and humanity, and lacks all compassion.

Since January 30th, 2008, I have been blackmailed, threatened, intimidated, lied to, abused, hospitalised and treated worse than a criminal - and all for no good reason. I have seen how America has become a tyrannical state. I have seen how it dehumanises those it considers those not worthy of respect - and this means anyone it so desires to destroy at a mere whim. And it is not just foreign travellers to America who suffer, I have known some of my more vulnerable friends suffer from a regime that would put some so-called anti-Western dictatorships to shame.

Cruelty comes in many forms. You can torture someone physically or you can torture someone mentally. Often, both go hand in hand. In America, people are tortured by means of deprivation and abuse of power - to name just two devices.

The Bush regime has created an uncontrolled monster called Homeland Security. They are the modern Gestapo - a police force which thinks it only has to answer to itself to justify any and all of it's corrupt activities.

Can the next President, Barack Obama, begin to change America? The answer is no. The obscene influences that kept the Bush regime in power for eight years will not go away. Obama not just has the task of making America more humane, he has to change the culture of his country if he is to make it respected by the rest of the world. Obviously, this will not happen. To paraphrase Obama, you can change the colour of the lipstick on the pig from red to blue, but America will still be a pig. The American pig has grown fat and ugly and will not give up it's place at the trough, regardless of what Obama may try to do to make it change it's nature.

Obama's biggest challenge will be not to repeat the mistakes of a famous predecessor to the White House - John ("Old Buck") Buchanan. Old Buck was a compromiser, a man who tried to please everyone but just caused political divisions which ultimately led to the (first?) American Civil War. While one would not expect the same thing to happen twice in the same manner, wars can be fought in many different ways. The old-fashioned idea of lining up ranks of troops against each other in the battlefield is no longer considered appropriate. After all, the Americans, and despite how desperate they may become, would never dream of such a scenario. The new civil war would be fought using modern tactics of scandal, blackmail, abuse, etc. Sounds familiar? I've seen first hand how depraved and evil elements of American society can be. In the modern civil war, there are no rules, no conditions, and mostly, there is no honour.

All is fair. Slowly, but surely, Obama will become a beleaguered President. I see no other prospect. A compromising President, as Obama alludes to be, will be nobody's friend. As much as his enemies will attack him for trying to reform the pig, those who payroll him will also turn against him for trying to unite that which cannot be united - ironically, the 'United' States of America. How soon before we begin to call this country the 'Disunited States of America'?

As for me, all I want is to get my possessions, see my wife and hopefully get her out of the country as soon as possible. We are both poor people with little or no money and no real hope of being permanently reunited in love BECAUSE of the hostility of America towards those who are in love. Our only hope is that someone, somewhere, can help us be together.

I hope this happens very quickly. I fear for the ruination of my marriage, if it is not already lost, and the loss of some very important personal possessions. Me and my wife ask for very little. But even begging for so little is beyond those who wield power in America. We are not considered worthy of any respect or compassion.

When a country like America, so powerful and influential, cannot recognise the heartbreak it can cause, then it augurs badly for the future of humanity. When the little people of this world, such as myself and my wife, are treated with such contempt, then what hope have those who are considered to have even less of a right to humanity?

Will someone please come forward and show me there is humanity in this world? When there is no respect, no justice, there should be retribution. As a last resort, it is one I would prefer to avoid. But I will not sit back and let myself and my wife suffer such denigrating treatment. Honour demands action.
